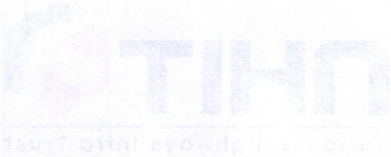

Bids from Joint ventures consortium, combination or any sort of arrangement between two or more than two entities, including Sub-Contracting, are not permitted.	It is clarified that the bidder may be either a single entity (natural person or private entity) or a group of entities formed to implement the project (a 'Joint Venture'). Bids from joint venture consortia, combinations, or any other type of arrangement between two or more entities, including subcontracting, are permitted as per following terms: a) Technical eligibility may be permitted to be fulfilled 100% through technology collaboration with an eligible OEM. b) Financial eligibility (turnover and net worth) may be allowed to be met through the consortium members collectively.

Minimum positive net worth requirement under Clause 2.13.3 (ii) – Financial Capacity	The bidder shall have a positive net worth of not less than INR 5 Crore as on 01.03.2026, supported by audited financial statements. Provisional financial statements shall be accepted. However, subjected to approval	The bidder shall have a positive net worth of not less than INR 3 Crore during the last three financial years or INR 5 Crore as on 01.03.2026, duly supported by audited financial statements. Provisional financial statements may also be submitted, subject to approval. Further, in either case, the bidder shall have a minimum average net profit of 10% during the last three consecutive financial years.
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Note: Bidders are advised to take note of the above changes made in the RFP while submitting their bids.
