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Section 1 - Notice Inviting Tender

- 1 The National Highways Infra Trust (hereinafter referred to as "NHIT" or "Company"), invites bids from eligible parties for providing "Road Assets Insurance for assets under National Highways Infra Trust (NHIT)" as detailed in this Request for Proposal ("RFP").
- 2 Service Provider will be selected under "Cost Based Selection" method as described in this RFP and in accordance with the practices of NATIONAL HIGHWAYS INFRA TRUST.
- 3 The RFP includes the following documents:

 - 3.2 Section 2 - Instructions to Bidders
 - 3.3 Section 3 - Scope of work

- 4 Brief Description of Bidding Process:
 - 4.1 National Highways Infra Trust has adopted single stage evaluation process for selection of the Bidder(s) for award of the work. the financial bid (the "Financial Bid") containing the amount quoted by the Bidder shall be submitted in physical form.
 - 4.2 The bidders may send their authorized representatives along with authorization letter on the letter head of the bidder for participation in the opening of the financial bid. Without such authorization letter, the concerned official of the respective bidder will not be allowed to participate and witness in Financial Bid opening. The Financial Bids will be opened physically at the location provided in such communications.
 - 4.3 The Financial Bids will be opened physically at Unit No.: 324, 3rd Floor, D21 - Corporate Park, Sector-21, Dwarka -110077, Delhi. Only one representative of the bidder shall be allowed to attend the opening of the Financial Bids.
 - 4.4 The financial proposal of each technically qualified bidder shall be opened and evaluated.

SECTION 2 – INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

2.1 Introduction

2.2 Proposal

- 2.2.1 National Highways Infra Trust (NHIT) seeks proposals for **Selection of Insurer for Assets Insurance of Road Assets under SPVs of NHIT** as per scope of work given in Section 3 – Scope of Work of the RFP document (“Works”).

2.3 Clarification and Amendment of RFP Documents

- 2.3.1 Bidders may request clarifications on any of the RFP documents up to the time mentioned in Section 1. Any request for clarification must be sent in writing NHIT address indicated in the RFP or by e-mail to Tender@nhit.co.in NHIT will respond in writing, or by e-mail/ uploading responses on website or will send written copies of the response (including an explanation of the query but without identifying the source of inquiry) to all Bidders. Should NHIT deem it necessary to amend the RFP as a result of clarification, it shall do so following the established procedure and inform the Bidders of the same through written communication or by uploading it on the website of NHIT.
- 2.3.2 At any time before the submission of the Bids, NHIT shall have the right to amend the RFP by issuing an addendum/ amendment in writing or by standard electronic means. The addendum/ amendment shall be uploaded to the website of www.nhit.co.in which will be binding on all Bidders. To give Bidders reasonable time for considering the addendum/ amendment in their Bids, NHIT may, if the addendum/ amendment is substantial, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of Bids.
- 2.3.3 It will be the responsibility of the Bidders to keep track of any uploaded addendum/ amendment before submission of the Bid.

2.4 Submission of Proposal

The proposal shall be submitted as indicated below:

- 2.4.1 ‘Sealed Envelope’ containing the ‘Financial Bid’ of the **“Request for Proposal (“RFP”) issued by National Highways Infra Trust (NHIT) for Selection of Insurer for Assets Insurance of Road Assets under SPVs of NHIT**. The proposal should be in the manner and format as prescribed in **Section 4 – Form of Financial Bid**. Please note that proposals with any conditionality will be summarily rejected.
- 2.4.2 Proposal (sealed envelope) marked as **“Bid – Proposal for the Request for Proposal (“RFP”) issued by National Highways Infra Trust (NHIT) for Selection of Insurer for Assets Insurance of Road Assets under SPVs of NHIT”** should reach the undersigned, latest by date/time mentioned in the Section 1 – Notice inviting Tender, in hard copies/in

original and shall remain valid for 120 days thereafter. The proposal should be signed by the authorized signatory of the Bidder, supported by the relevant authorization document. No Proposal will be entertained after the due time and date, as stated above. NHIT shall not be responsible for any delay whatsoever in nature. The proposals received after the due date and date will be summarily rejected.

- 2.4.3 NHIT reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the offers received without assigning any reason. For any clarification, you may feel free to contact the undersigned.

2.5 Modification/Substitution/Withdrawal of Bids

- 2.5.1 The Bidder may substitute or withdraw its bid after submission prior to the Bid due date. No Bid shall be allowed to be substituted or withdrawn by the Bidder on or after the Bid due date.
- 2.5.2 Any alteration/modification in the Bid or additional information supplied subsequent to the Bid Due Date, unless the same has been expressly sought for by NHIT, shall be disregarded.
- 2.5.3 Partial modification of the Bid is not allowed. The Bidder will have to submit the revised bid again in a sealed envelope, as per Clause 2.4 above, mentioning "Revised Bid" on the top of the sealed envelope and the original bid envelope will be returned to the Bidder. No Bid may be modified after the Bid Due Date. Withdrawal or modification of Bids between the Bid Due Date and Expiration of Bid validity shall result in disqualification from the bidding process.

2.6 Opening and Evaluation of the Bids

- 2.6.1 The Bids will be opened after the due date at the time prescribed in the RFP document in the presence of the Bidders who choose to attend. NHIT will subsequently examine and evaluate the Bids in accordance with the provisions set out herein.
- 2.6.2 Financial Bid of non-responsive Bidders shall not be considered.
- 2.6.3 To assist in the examination, evaluation, and comparison of Bids, NHIT may, at its discretion, ask any Bidder for clarification of its Bid. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing or by e-mail, but no change in the price or substance of the Bid shall be sought, offered, or permitted except as required to confirm the correction of arithmetic errors discovered by NHIT in the evaluation of the Bids.
- 2.6.4 Except in case any clarification is asked for by NHIT, no Bidder shall contact NHIT on any matter relating to its Bid from the time of the Bid opening to the time the contract is awarded. If any Bidder wishes to bring additional information to the notice of NHIT, it should do so in writing at the address prescribed in the Notice Inviting Tender.

2.7 Prior to evaluation of the Bids, the NHIT shall determine whether each Bid is responsive to the requirements of this RFP document. A Bid will be declared non-responsive in case:

- 2.7.1 If a Bidder submits more than one Bid against this RFP.
- 2.7.2 The physical bid submissions are incomplete/ inadequate to the requirements of the RFP Documents.
- 2.7.3 If in case the Power of Attorney or the Authority Letter is not provided.
- 2.7.4 If a Bidder submits a conditional Bid or makes changes to the terms and conditions given in this RFP document.
- 2.7.5 Failure to comply with all the requirements of RFP document by a Bidder.
- 2.7.6 If the Bid is not submitted in the formats prescribed in the RFP document.
- 2.7.7 If any requisite document/ certificate is not in the prescribed format the same shall not be considered while evaluating the bids and the same may lead to Bid being declared as non- responsive.
- 2.7.8 If the envelope containing physical submission is not sealed and marked as prescribed in the RFP document.
- 2.7.9 A Bid is valid for a period of time shorter than prescribed in the RFP document.

2.8 Conflict of Interest

- 2.8.1 Bidders at all times shall provide professional, objective, and impartial advice and at all times hold the NHIT Entities interest paramount, strictly avoid conflicts with other assignments or their own corporate interests and act without any consideration for future work. No two Bidders can have the same constituents or any such arrangement pursuant to which any third party is in a position to have access to confidential information of each other.
- 2.8.2 NDA clause to be signed between NHIT and the Agency/firm post release of the LOA, if required by NHIT.

2.9 Fraud and Corruption

- 2.9.1 Bidders would be required to observe the highest standard of ethics during the selection and execution of such work. NHIT defines:
 - 2.9.1.1 "Corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the selection process or in contract execution; and
 - 2.9.1.2 "Fraudulent practice" means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a selection process or the execution of a contract to the detriment of the NHIT and includes collusive practices among bidders (prior to or after submission of proposals) and to deprive the NHIT of the benefits of free and open competition.
- 2.9.2 NHIT will reject a proposal for Proposal/Selection if it determines that the bidder recommended for Engagement has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent activities in competing for the work in question.
- 2.9.3 NHIT will declare a bidder ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be

engaged if at any time determines that the bidder has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in the bidding process for Engagement for the subject work.

2.9.4 The bidder declared ineligible for corrupt and fraudulent practices by NHIT in accordance with the above paras shall not be eligible for selection.

2.10 Consortium of Bidders is not allowed.

2.11 Engagement Period

NHIT propose to Appoint Agency/firm for a period of One year.

2.12 Termination

2.13 Minimum Eligibility Criteria of Qualified Bidders

Bidder Eligibility Criteria to be considered for selection by the NHIT, the bidders should meet the following criteria:

2.13.1 The Bidder/ Company should have cumulative revenue/ turnover of minimum Rs 2,500.00 crores during the last three financial years ending 31/03/2023, 31/03/2024 and 31/03/2025. Certified copies of financial statements or certificate of turnover from Statutory Auditor/ Chartered Accountant of the Bidder to be submitted along with the bid.

2.13.2 The Bidder shall not be an associate of the Sponsor i.e., NHAI, or NHIT or IDBI Trusteeship Services Limited.

2.13.3 **Legal Entity:** The bidder should be a Legal Entity registered under the Companies Act, 2013 or the Companies Act, 1956 OR a Limited Liability Partnership (LLP) registered under the LLP Act, 2008 or Indian Partnership Act 1932.

2.13.4 **Blacklisting:** The bidder should not be debarred/ blacklisted by any Government/ PSU in India as on date of submission of the Bid.

2.13.5 **Legal:** The bidder should not be subjected to any legal action for any cause in any legal jurisdiction in the last five years which would materially affect its ability to perform under this RFP

2.14 Dis-Qualification Criteria:

NHIT may at its sole discretion and at any time during the evaluation of proposal, disqualify any respondent, if the respondent:

- 2.14.1 Submit the proposal documents after the bid due date.
- 2.14.2 Made misleading or false representations in the forms, statements and attachments submitted in proof of the eligibility requirements.
- 2.14.3 Failed to provide related clarifications, when sought.
- 2.14.4 Respondent or its directors declared ineligible, debarred by CPSU/ SPSU/ Government companies/ Government organizations/ regulatory authorities for corrupt and fraudulent practices or blacklisted.
- 2.14.5 Bidders who submit their bid as JV other than as provided in this document, to meet eligibility criteria will not be considered as qualified bidders. Such, JV bidder will be considered ineligible and summarily rejected.

2.15 Bid Proposal

The bidder who qualifies minimum eligibility criteria and quotes the lowest financial offer will be eligible for the Engagement.

2.16 Procedure for Engagement

- 2.16.1 Post qualification of the minimum eligibility criteria, the bidder(s) will be engaged under Cost Based Selection (“CBS”) method as described in this section (i.e. 2.15) and in accordance with the practices of NHIT.
- 2.16.2 The Engagement of Agency/firm amongst the eligible agency/firm will be done by NHIT at its own discretion. Accordingly, NHIT has the right to award the work to any of the selected agency/firm, depending on the exigencies, nature and magnitude of the Work.
- 2.16.3 The Authority may, at its sole discretion, undertake price negotiations with the Lowest Evaluated Responsive Bidder (L1). No bidder shall have any right to claim negotiations as a matter of right.
- 2.16.4 The Authority further reserves the right to annul the bidding process or reject any or all bids without incurring any liability

2.17 Timelines and Payment Schedule:

Bidder are advised to see the Table 3.1 in the section – 3 for detailed Scope of Works.

2.18 Payment terms:

The Premiums shall be payable as per payment schedule after submission of an appropriate tax invoice/proforma Invoice.

2.19 Documents to be submitted along with the Bid.

- 2.19.1 Either power of attorney or an authority letter from Partner/Board/Managing Committee of the Bidder entity should be provided for authentication of the authorized signatory signing the Bid document.
- 2.19.2 Bid in the form provided in the RFP duly signed by the authorized representative of the bidder on all pages.
- 2.19.3 Detailed profile of the Bidder certified by Authorized Signatory of the Bidder.
- 2.19.4 Documents in support of the claims of Bidder regarding eligibility/ experience duly signed by the authorized representative of the bidder on all pages. NHIT may ask for 3rd party certificates from the Bidder(s), at a later stage.
- 2.19.5 Undertaking in the format provided in the RFP duly signed by the authorized representative of the bidder on all pages.
- 2.19.6 Company profile including Registration certificate, GST Certificate and MSME Certificate if applicable.

2.20 Financial Bids / Fees

- 2.20.1 The Bidder is required to submit a financial proposal as per Section 4 – Form of Financial Proposal.
- 2.20.2 The fee quoted should be unconditional.
- 2.20.3 NHIT shall pay the Insurer the fees as per the Financial Proposal of the Bidder, as sole compensation for the Policies required as per section -3.
- 2.20.4 The fees shall be payable as per the payment schedule after submission of an appropriate tax invoice/proforma Invoice.
- 2.20.5 All the expenses including those related to the scope of services, travelling, manpower or any other out of pocket expense shall be borne by the bidders.

2.21 Key Terms and Conditions of Engagement

2.23 Commencement of Works:

Immediate after expiry of existing policy.

2.24 MSME Agency/Firm:

Bidder shall confirm if they are/are not registered as Micro Enterprise/ Small Enterprise/ Medium Enterprise. The registered Bidder shall submit Registration no. along with Registration Certificate issued. Bidder shall also confirm that any change in Status of their organization under the above Act shall be duly informed to NHIT. Any failure on their part in informing them about changed status shall be sole responsibility of Bidder.

2.25 Safety & Work Practice:

2.26 Indemnification:

The Agency shall hold the harmless and shall indemnify the same against all claims, penalties, fines, losses, damages, costs and proceedings arising from the breach or contravention of any laws, rules and regulations referred to in RFP.

2.27 Anti-Bribery & Corruption (ABC) Policy:

It is our policy to conduct all our business in an honest and ethical manner. We take a zero-tolerance approach to Bribery and Corruption and are committed to acting professionally, fairly and with integrity in all our business dealings and relationships wherever we operate and implementing and enforcing effective systems to counter bribery. 2.28 Resolutions of Disputes:

Any dispute arising out of the RFP, which cannot be amicably settled between the parties, shall be referred to arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 through a panel of three arbitrators, with each of NHIT and the remaining disputing party(s) appointing one arbitrator and the two arbitrators so appointed appointing a third arbitrator. Provided that in the event that any disputing parties fail to appoint an arbitrator within 15 days from the dispute being referred to arbitration, the other parties shall be at liberty to appoint an arbitrator for such disputing party(s) and such appointment shall be final and binding on the other disputing parties. The venue of the arbitration shall be at New Delhi.

2.29 Force Majeure

A Force Majeure (FM) means extraordinary events or circumstance beyond human control such as an event described as an act of God (like a natural calamity) or events such as a war, strike, riots, crimes (but not including negligence or wrong-doing, predictable/seasonal rain and any other events specifically excluded in the clause). In the case of an FM, the contract frees both parties (NHIT & the Agency/Firm) from contractual liability or obligation when prevented by such events from fulfilling their obligations under the contract. However, this does not excuse a party's non-performance entirely, but only suspends it for the duration of the FM. The parties have to give notice of FM as soon as it occurs, and it cannot be claimed ex-post facto. If the performance in whole or in part or any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by any FM for a period exceeding 90 (Ninety) days, NHIT may at its option terminate the contract without any financial repercussion on other side.

Notwithstanding the punitive provisions contained in the contract for delay or breach of contract, the Agency/Firm would not be liable for imposition of any such sanction so long as the delay and/or failure of the supplier in fulfilling its obligations under the contract is the result of an event covered in the FM clause.

2.30 Governing Law and Jurisdiction

This RFP and the subsequent agreement between the parties shall be interpreted by and shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of India. The Courts at New Delhi, India shall have sole jurisdiction over all matters arising out of or relating to this agreement.

2.31 Ethics & integrity:

The selected Insurer is expected to maintain a high level of professional ethics and will not act in any manner, which is detrimental to NHIT's Interest.

2.32 Matter of Confidentiality:

Each agency/firm Agency/firm will maintain confidentiality on matters disclosed.

2.33 LOA Acknowledgement:

As a token of acceptance, you are requested to acknowledge the receipt of this letter with official seal & sign form the authorized signatory along with all Annexures (if any) - within 3 working days and initiate the process for the signing of the Agreement.

2.34 Right of Removal:

NHIT will have the right to remove any selected Agency/firm from the selection list without assigning any reason whatsoever and without any cost & compensation therefore NHIT also reserves the right to replace/remove/ Empanel any new agency/firm as the Agency/firm for an ongoing or future Requirements at any stage.

2.35 GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 2.35.1 The agency/firm is solely responsible for ensuring the timely submission of their Bids at our office.
- 2.35.2 It has been duly incorporated in India and is valid as per the existing laws of India.
- 2.35.3 It shall not violate any proprietary and/ or intellectual property rights of any third party, including without limitation, confidential relationships, patents, trade secrets, copyright and/or any other proprietary rights.
- 2.35.4 Will not contravene any provision of any law, statute, rule or regulation or any order, writ, injunction or decree of any court, governmental instrumentality or Governmental Authority to which it is subject.
- 2.35.5 The signatory to this agreement has due authority and power in its favor to execute this Agreement and bind and such authority and power is still valid and subsisting.
- 2.35.6 This Agreement constitutes legal, valid and binding obligations of such Party enforceable in accordance with its terms; and
- 2.35.7 The execution and delivery of, and the performance of obligations under and in compliance with the provisions of this Agreement will not result in: (i) a violation of any

terms and conditions of Articles of Association, Memorandum of Association or any other relevant charter documents of respective party whereby the respective Parties are constituted; or (ii) a breach of, or constitute a default under, any instructions to which it is a party or by which it is bound; or (iii) a violation of any law or regulation in any jurisdiction having the force of law or of any order, judgment or decree of any court or governmental agency or agreement to which it is a party or by which it is bound.

- 2.35.8 That the successful Bidder is not misleading NHIT in any way.
- 2.35.9 No litigation, arbitration or administrative proceeding is presently taking place, pending to the knowledge of the successful Bidder threatened against or otherwise involving the successful Bidder which could have an adverse effect on its business, assets or financial condition or upon NHIT's reputation.
